



Original Parts Contract

In an effort to save both time and paper, as well as better prepare our advanced students for collegiate and post-high school ensemble expectations, the SFHS Varsity Wind Symphony will be checking out and using "ORIGINAL PARTS" during the 2022-2023 school year. This is what can be expected in collegiate, most community, and professional ensembles.

What is an original part? Original Parts are the "Original" set of scores and parts that are sold to our school or district when a piece of music is purchased from a publisher or composer. These parts are sometimes oversized, or on cardstock, and are what we use to make any necessary copies. This means that if an "Original" is missing from a piece set, it must be re-purchased in order for the piece to be playable. In some instances, if a part is missing, and individual part cannot be purchased and the entire set must be reordered. In this sense, original parts are to be treated similarly to text books for our class.

Rules For Originals:

- DO NOT write on original parts with anything other than an erasable pencil. All pencil markings from rehearsals will be erased at the end of the concert set, before the part is returned to our library. Any other markings will cause the part to need replacing.
- DO NOT bend, fold, tear, soil, dampen, or damage the parts in anyway. They should be kept only in your oversized black band folder, and treated with care. Damaged parts will need to be replaced.
- DO NOT lose your folder or parts. A lost part must be replaced.
- YOU MAY, if you choose, make copies of your part, for your own use. You may also return your original part for safe-keeping once you have made the copy. This is your choice.

Any lost or damaged parts will result in the student being charged for the part. Similar to a lost or damaged text or chrome book, a hold will be placed on the student's account until the charge has been paid. If an individual part cannot be purchased, an entire set will need to be purchased.
